



Appointment of Redmoor Community Advisor

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New Age Exploration Limited (“NAE” or “the Company”) announces that NAE Resources (UK) Limited, the Company’s joint venture with Strategic Minerals Plc (AIM: SML) and owner of the Redmoor Tin-Tungsten Project, has entered a consulting arrangement with Jeffrey Harrison, as its Community Advisor for the Redmoor Project. Jeffrey will represent the Redmoor joint venture in its engagement with the local community and in progressing land access for the planned drilling program scheduled to commence in the first half of 2017.

Jeffrey Harrison is an experienced mining engineer, operations manager and general manager, with over 35 years’ experience in the mining industry. More recently, he was the Operations Manager for Wolf Minerals, where he provided similar services that were instrumental in gaining landowner and community support necessary for the development of the Drakelands tungsten mine, commissioned in 2015 and located 40km from the Company’s mine site in Devon. Jeffrey lives in Cornwall approximately 20km from the Redmoor project.

NAE Managing Director, Gary Fietz, commented: “We are delighted to have secured the services of such an experienced operator, particularly as both NAE and SML consider this role as critical to our interaction with the local community.

The appointment of Jeffrey is another positive step towards undertaking the planned exploration drilling program at Redmoor scheduled to commence in the first half of 2017. This, along with our JV partner, SML’s oversubscribed £600,000 capital raising completed last week, and the £101,700 payment made by SML in September for the Redmoor pre-drilling activities to be advanced, provide increased confidence on next year’s drilling program at Redmoor”.
